Classes begin the week of September 11, 2017.

Preschool offers fun and educational hands on learning activities for children ages 3, 4 and 5. Preschool classes are held at Waverly and Winsted sites. Scholarship and transportation information is available.

Students who attend Howard Lake-Waverly-Winsted District 2687 Preschools have the opportunity to grow emotionally, physically, academically and socially. This is accomplished by focusing on the Minnesota Early Learning

Standards called the Early Childhood Indicators of Progress.

These six indicators are:

- social and emotional development
- language and literacy development
- cognitive development
- approaches to learning
- creativity and the arts
- physical and motor development

HLWW District 2687 Preschool uses Creative Curriculum, the GOLD Assessment System, OWL and Everyday Math curriculums to achieve positive outcomes for children as they attend preschool.

The Gold Assessment tool is a guideline to drive curriculum and meet the needs of students specified by the indicators. By evaluating and planning, staff implements each child's learning experience and helps students reach their full potential by challenging students.

3 & 4 year old classes

For children who will enter kindergarten the fall of 2018 or who have attended one of our 2016-17 preschool sessions.

Tuesdays & Thursdays	12:15-3 pm	Fee: \$100 per month
Friday morning	8:15-10:45 am	Fee: \$42 per month additional, when attending a two day class for 4-5 year olds.
Mondays, Wednesdays & Fridays	12:15-3 pm	Fee: \$142 per month
